High School Information

Students entering 11th grade are required to have a physical exam. This is a state requirement. Please physical forms by the first day of school.

Required gym/practice uniforms will be available in August. Gym shorts are \$15. Gym shirts are \$13 for 1, \$24 for 2 or \$36 for 3. Purchase from Mrs. Pettis in the MS/HS Office.

All West-Mont Algebra II, Trigonometry, and Calculus students are required to have the same calculator to help with math applications in the classroom. The required models are the TI-83, TI-83 PLUS, TI-84 or TI-84 PLUS. (TI stands for Texas Instruments.) These four calculators are basically identical except for one minor application. The TI-83 is no longer sold new, but can be picked up used on eBay. These calculators normally go on sale in late July or August at local national chain stores.

Geometry Students will need a scientific calculator, but do not have to have the expensive TI-83 or TI-84. A good typical brand is a TI-30X that normally sells for about \$15. If they have a TI-83 PLUS or TI-84 they are welcome to use it in class.
